MINUTES

Daily Briefing February 24, 2017
Greene County Commission Office
9:30 a.m.

Presiding Commissioner Bob Cirtin called the meeting of February 24, 2017 to order.

Highway Action Items

Jeff Avers presented an action item to the Commission requesting they sign a lease agreement for the Sutherland property. Avers said the agreement had already been read and approved by County Counselor John Housley and Highway Director Rick Artman. (See Exhibit A)

Pretrial Update

Stephanie Hamilton, Amy Walker, Jarod Denney, Sharon Marshall, and Bret Kaiser presented an update to Commission. The group explained that a recent memo sent to the Judges regarding the type of cases Pretrial will accept received a little pushback but will continue to communicate with the Judges as this is implemented. Pretrial will not accept high-risk subjects based on a criteria form approved by the Commission and Chris Coulter. Lincoln Hough asked to set up a tour with Pretrial in the near future.

Primary Seatbelt Ordinance

Bob Cirtin discussed a possible primary seatbelt ordinance for unincorporated Greene County. The ordinance would heighten the severity of riding without a seatbelt to a misdemeanor crime

instead of an infraction. It could also be used for probable cause. Cirtin said the Prosecuting Attorney Dan Patterson is okay with it but said it's not practical to assign a prosecutor to handle it. He suggested it might be possible to utilize the Missouri Fine Collection Center in Jefferson City. Cirtin will look into this further and keep the other Commissioners updated.

Industrial Development Authority Board Vacancy

It was determined that IDA Board Member Wayne Morelock's term ended in September 2016. The Commission asked Kate Morris to check with the IDA chairperson to see if Morelock's attendance and participation was satisfactory and, if so, to proceed with setting him up for a reappointment.

Resource Management Update

Kevin Barnes was present to give an update, however, due to time constraints, Barnes agreed to postpone his update to the next Briefing.
