No-Excuse Absentee Voting Hours on Saturday, March 30

Springfield, MO - Greene County Clerk Shane Schoeller announces to all eligible voters wishing to vote absentee for the General Municipal Election on Tuesday, April 2 that no-excuse absentee voting will be available **in person** at the Greene County Elections Center, 1126 N. Boonville Ave. in Springfield, on **Saturday, March 30 from 9:00 am to 1:00 pm**.

In-person absentee voting will also be available Thursday and Friday, March 28 and 29 and Monday, April 1 at the following locations and during the hours listed:

- Greene County Elections Center, 1126 N. Boonville Ave. 8:00 am to 5:00 pm
- The Library Center, 4653 S. Campbell Ave. 9:00 am to 4:00 pm

Please note that in order to vote in-person absentee, by statute voters must present one of the following forms of photo identification:

- A nonexpired Missouri driver or non-driver license;
- A nonexpired military ID, including a veteran's ID card;
- A nonexpired United States passport;
- A photo ID issued by the United States or the state of Missouri which is either not expired or expired after the date of the most recent general election.
- A photo ID issued by the United States or the state of Missouri which is without an expiration date.
