The Greene County Sheriff Department, Jail Division, is seeking a qualified individual for the position of Licensed Practical Nurse to provide inmate medical care, under the supervision of the Medical Supervisor.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

The LPN assists jail physician with sick call; prepares and dispenses inmate medication. Screens inmates for medical conditions and writes reports. Assists and treats medical emergencies. Escorts prisoners to clinic or special appointments. Performs physical examinations. Interviews outside sources to obtain inmates medical histories and maintains medical records. Maintains and orders medical supplies and medications. Performs other duties as required of position.

Minimum Experience and Training Qualifications:

A valid Missouri EMT-P or LPN license is required, plus one year medical clinical and treatment experience, or any combination of education and experience that provides equivalent knowledge, skills, and abilities. A valid Missouri motor vehicle operator's license is required.

A complete description of the physical and mental abilities required to perform the essential functions of the position is available at the Greene County Human Resources Office.

Special Requirements:

All applicants are required to undergo screening for the presence of illegal drugs, and a post-offer physical examination, criminal background and reference checks.
