LEPC GENERAL COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES

Date: Thursday, February 18, 2010
Time: 11:30 a.m.
Location: The Pasta House Co., 4109 S. National

The December LEPC General Membership meeting was called to order by Chair, Lisa Cardone at 12:00 a.m. Introductions were made around the room.

Chair Lisa Cardone called for any changes to the minutes of the December 17, 2009 general membership meeting. No changes were brought forth. The minutes were approved as presented.

OLD BUSINESS

Ryan Nicholls gave the Financial Statement Report for the LEPC. To date approximately \$26,200 has been spent (35%) of the LEPC budget. Complete Treasurer's Reports were available for those that wanted one to review.

The MERC meeting is in March so there was no update on MERC this month.

Shea gave the regional HAZMAT and WMD Planning Update. There is around \$45,000 in HSRRS grant funds which is continuing to move forward. As training sessions are set up they will be posted on the OEM website. RMP (Risk Management Plan) issues are progressing; John Elmore is working on these for Greene County.

Ty gave a training update. OPS and Awareness classes are on the calendar now and can be viewed from the LEPC website. Sign up is through the SEMA website. Additional classes will be posted as they are scheduled.

John Elmore provided an update on CERT training and events. Missouri State University CERT classes are progressing. The next class is set to start in April. John will provide CERT training on-site to groups that can sign up enough students. LEPC members were encouraged to watch the LEPC website for new class details and to enroll if they have not yet attended a CERT class.

Other Old Business:

Lisa asked for other old business.

Fire Chief David Hall gave a legislative update regarding spill response. The issue of this new proposed law is the recovery of expenditures local fire/emergency response teams will be allowed to bill the spill-responsible entity. If passed this has potential to change or end the regional hazmat teams; and the response capability due to the costs the team itself will incur. DNR could be the new spill-responsible entity. David will keep the LEPC updated as this legislation moves forward.

Lisa asked for additional old business. None was brought forth.

NEW BUSINESS

Ty Davisson gave the airport full-scale exercise (FSX) presentation. The FSX was August 26th at the Springfield airport. The exercise scenario was a hijacking event and also included a situation designed to test the HSRRS system response to an unknown explosive. There were identified lessons learned and areas that could be improved. Training is planned to address some of the identified weaker areas. The FBI participated for the first time here in Springfield. It was a successful exercise. The full After Action Report is on the website.

Lisa presented the nominations for the LEPC Executive Committee which were Ralph Siccama for Chair and J.R. Webb, J. D. Landon, Mark Pon and Dennis Clinton for the two Member-at-Large positions. Additional nominations from the floor were asked for. No additional nominations were brought forth. Karen made a motion to elect Ralph for Chair by acclamation which was seconded by J. R. A vote was held and passed. Election ballots were passed out and each member was asked to vote for 2 people to be the member-at-large representatives for the two year terms. After two votes J. R. Webb and Mark Pon were elected to these two positions.

The April LEPC General Membership meeting will be held at the Office of Emergency Management with lunch catered. Members were asked for topics they want to discuss. None were brought forth.

Other New Business was called for by Lisa.

With no additional business brought forth; a motion was made by J D Landon and seconded by Ryan Nicholls to adjourn. A vote was held and passed.

Lisa announced the meeting to be adjourned at 12:31 pm.
