NOTICE OPEN MEETING

LEPC GENERAL COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES

Date: Thursday April 21, 2011

Time: 11:30 a.m.

Location: Office of Emergency Management, 833 Boonville in Springfield

The April LEPC General Membership meeting was called to order by Chair, Ralph Siccama at 11:51 a.m. Introductions were made around the room.

J. D. Landon made a motion to accept the February 24, 2011 LEPC General Membership minutes as presented. No changes were brought forth. This was seconded by J R. Webb. A vote was held and passed. The minutes were approved as presented.

OLD BUSINESS

Ryan Nicholls provided the Financial Statement for the LEPC. Approximately 80% funding has been spent this fiscal year. Hard copies of the Treasurer's Report were available for those that wanted one to review and will be posted on-line. A new budget will be coming in June.

Lisa Cardone reported on MERC. There is a MERC RMP grant available for \$45,000 to reach Teir 2 non-reporters. This year they have 8,006 facilities reporting in Missouri and have collected approximately \$753,000; which comes back to benefit the local LEPCs in Missouri. MERC also has funding available to assist attendees to the Region 7 conference July 28-30. LEPC award nominees are being taken now for this conference. EPA has added 16 new chemicals to the reportable TRI list.

Shea gave the regional HAZMAT and WMD Planning Update. To date this year there have been 22 DNR spill reports from Greene County and one nuclear waste shipment that transported through Greene County. 2009 grant expenditures have been made and are almost complete. New SWAT tactical masks were purchased with RSOC funds that were not expended. The 2010 grant has begun the spend down. The 2011 funds are just coming out so there is potential for three funding years to be open at the same time.

Warren gave the CERT update. CERT has completed 2 classes this year. Sixty MoDOT employees have been trained. There are three CERT classes scheduled in May. April 28

CERT will have an earthquake symposium from 6-9 pm after the Shakeout exercise. See Warren if you want additional information.

NEW BUSINESS

Dr. Johnson was not available to provide his report today so Ty presented the TEPW report is complete and in the mail. The primary capability based training and exercise need identified was WMD and Hazmat response and decontamination. The report has the three year community exercise and training calendar which builds upon itself; starting with tabletop exercises and building to discussion based and full-scale exercises to increase community capability. This calendar is still a work in progress and will be detailed as needed. The National Level Exercise is in May. The Springfield/Branson National Airport will have a tabletop exercise in August. In September there will be an alternate EOC drill. In 2012 and 13 USPS exercises are expected. Get with Ty if you want to participate more in any of these activities.

June 16th is the next meeting – information will be coming via e-mail as usual.

Ralph called for other new business.

Wendall Hall said Randall Willoughby of his DNR office has more chemical suicide classes scheduled in May, these are listed on the SEMA training website.

Shea asked for all facilities to provide him with their latest EOP. He is updating the OEM files and found several to be out of date. See Shea if you have further questions or need any assistance with your plans.

Ralph called for other new business.

None was brought forth.

A motion was made by Karen and seconded by JD Landon to adjourn the meeting. Ralph adjourned the meeting at 12:16 pm.
