The October LEPC General Membership meeting was called to order by Chair, Ralph Siccama at 11:59 a.m. Introductions were made around the room.

Warren Robinson made a motion to accept the August 25, 2011 LEPC General Membership minutes as presented. This was seconded by Dennis Clinton. A vote was held and passed. The minutes were approved as presented.

OLD BUSINESS

Ryan Nicholls provided the Financial Statement for the LEPC. To date \$8,273.83 has been spent leaving \$15,027.37 in the budget. Some of the expenses are for training. Hard copies of the Treasurer's Report and 2011-12 budget were available for those that wanted one to review and will be posted on-line.

Ryan gave the regional HAZMAT and WMD Planning Update. The OEM is working on a new Hazmat/WMD plan that is regional, including 18 counties of SW Missouri.

The update on the TEPW and training highlighted the recent chemical suicide training MDNR has been providing and the recent local chemical suicide. The training provided is timely and will assist in these cases which are local now.

The Anhydrous Ammonia class had 20 attendees on October 14th and will most likely be repeated next year.

Hazmat Tech course will be October 24-28 at Battlefield Fire Department and there are still a few seats available. This course has some prerequisites. Sign up on-line. Next year this course may change to an 80-120 hour modular class so if you need it get it done this year.

December February 15th is the next general membership meeting; information will be coming via e-mail as usual.
