Important Points from LEPC State Conference

- Make sure that we know who to have the Band check made out to in order to pay the band the night of the performance.
- Hold the conference on Thursday and Friday, no Saturdays
- Comments indicate the accommodations were positive.
- The food was good, no complaints.
- Too much food set up for the volunteers, need about ½ as much
- Need to have bottled water available for the speakers.
- Need to have a description of each class in the registration packets, some participants commented the class was not what they expected.
- Use the list of door prizes when giving them away. (We forgot the refrigerated cheese boxes).
- Registration went well, probably only needed 2 people working it.
- The Volunteer and Command Rooms worked very well.
- The radios worked well for communication between the 2 buildings.
- Should have done more work on CEU and post credits beforehand.
- All the tracks went well no issues or negative comments were received.
- Need to make the schedule of room locations easier to read.
- The large printouts of the schedule were great.

- If next conference is only 2 days and 1 night, do the vendor reception and banquet on the same night.
- The vendor reception went well, but the banquet attendance was poor. We had only about 40 people eat dinner and then within the first hour there were only 15 people left at the dance.
- State required a “formal” bidding process for the hotel vendor. Need to get the specifics on this beforehand.
- The time of the year was great for the conference (minus the tornado watches/warnings).
- It was a good it didn’t rain because of having the conference in 2 separate buildings. This was a small drawback to using the Oasis location.
- The vendor banner size was adequate.
