LEPC GENERAL COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES

The August LEPC General Membership meeting was called to order by Chair, Lisa Cardone at 11:30 A.M.

Introductions were made by all in attendance.

OLD BUSINESS

Ryan Nicholls gave the Financial Statement Report for the LEPC. The 2008-2009 Budget is \$42,919.00. He reported that the new budget was set on what we expect to receive from the HMEP and CEPF grants for 2008-2009.

Shea Lane gave the regional HAZMAT and WMD Planning Update. He reports that the State has come up with guidelines that HAZMAT Exercise Teams must meet and State Auditors to insure that those guidelines are met as well as to assess what their capabilities are. He also reported that several HSRT teams have opted out.

Members were encouraged to send any useful website links they may have to the LEPC Executive members for consideration and addition to the LEPC website.

Michael was recognized for his outstanding contributions, input and insights to the committee in helping them reach the LEPC goals. He was also recognized as a key person in the recent revision and rewrite of the LEPC Guidelines. Congratulations and thanks, Mike!

Lisa Cardone reported on the Membership packets which are currently being developed. Members were encouraged to send in flyers, brochures, stickers, etc., anything about their organization that could be included in the packets. There are plans to print and distribute 200 packets by the end of October 2008.

Updates from Springfield Fire, Health, DNR, City Utilities, Postal Service, CERT Program and the Safety Council were presented.

A motion was made and seconded to adjourn the meeting and all interested to proceed to the parking lot to tour the new Region D Communications Truck, Trailer and the new DNR vehicle.
