DEADLINE TO REGISTER WEDNESDAY

Greene County Clerk Richard Struckhoff reminds residents they have until this Wednesday, July

7, to become registered for the August 3 Primary Election.

"Those who are not registered may apply at any one of our many permanent voter registration

locations, including libraries, colleges, city halls, and the courthouse," Struckhoff said. Mail-in

(postcard) registrations will also be accepted if they are postmarked by July 7.

The August 3 ballot features four Party Primaries (Democrat, Republican, Libertarian, and

Constitution), and one statewide issue.

When registering to vote, be sure to bring along a driver's license, federal or state ID or other

acceptable identification. Under state and federal laws, registered voters are not disqualified for

moving within a county, but Struckhoff urges anyone who has moved or changed their name to

contact his office as soon as possible to avoid unnecessary delays on election day.
